COSTUMES FOR JUNE SHOW

Right now, I am trying to limit to producers that prepare costumes quickly. We will re-measure all students during the month of February to have the most 'up to date' measurements for costume sizing. As things are so fluid and changing right now, I ask that parents are understanding and cooperative in this regard. I am going to do my best to do make the most appropriate decisions we can with the information we have at the time.

Once costumes are ordered, the fees are non-refundable. I will keep you posted on the situation and I am hopeful that things will be more stable, and we can have an amazing June Show with costumes... and never close again!
